Dear Church Family & Friends.

Some time ago, I got an important lesson about communication . I was reading the newspaper during breakfast with my wife, Terry. She was

talking to me, but I continued reading.

Terry commented, "You did not hear a word I said!" I replied, "I heard every word. I will repeat it, word for word." Which I did. Terry was not happy about it.

Experts say that communication is:

7% is what is said (information)

38% is how it is said (pauses, volume of your voice, etc.)

55% is body language (eye contact, leaning toward, etc.)

Who was right? The above formula explains why I was wrong. Body language is more than half of the message. Overpowering what I said and how I said it.

If you want to communicate effectively, make sure all three send the same message. It is not about fooling someone - it is about knowing and caring enough to send the right message.

How can you communicate better? And with whom?

Now connect this to Romans 5:8. "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."




