





Mike's sermon this coming week is on the "Crowded Heart" and since seeing his sermon title, it has really got me thinking about how crowded my life has become and how I can condense and eliminate many of those things by being thoughtful about my commitments.

A crowded heart is one that is overwhelmed by the cares of this world. Jesus addressed this issue in the Parable of the Sower, where He described seeds falling among thorns, which choked the plants, preventing them from bearing fruit (Matthew 13:22). The thorns represent the worries of life and the deceitfulness of wealth, which can crowd out the word of God from our hearts.

Do you have constant anxiety and stress that can indicate that our hearts are too focused on worldly concerns or are feeling distant from God and are struggling to find joy in spiritual practices or even having difficulty concentrating during prayer, Bible study, or worship services?

To overcome this, we need to eliminate those things that are causing us stress, but we also need to prioritize time with God. Make it a goal to set aside dedicated time each day for prayer and Bible reading. This should help refocus our hearts on what truly matters. We also need to remember that God cares for us and is ultimately in control. Trust in God and He can alleviate the burden of worry.

In doing so, we can experience the peace and joy that comes from a heart fully devoted to Him.
