


Bible Presentation for 5th, 6th, 7th Graders

Pastor Mike has been preaching on living our best life and in order to do that, we need to know how to beb a Christian. A Christian heart is often described as one that embodies the teachings and love of Jesus Christ. At its core, it is characterized by compassion, humility, and a deep sense of love for others. Here are some key aspects that define a Christian heart:

- 1. Love and Compassion Jesus taught that the greatest commandments are to love God and to love others as oneself (Matthew 22:37-39). This love is not just a feeling, but an active commitment to care for others, showing compassion and kindness, especially to those in need.
- 2. Forgiveness A Christian heart is forgiving. Jesus emphasized the importance of forgiveness, teaching that we should forgive others as God forgives us (Matthew 6:14-15). This means letting go of grudges and extending grace to those who have wronged us.
- 3. Humility is another hallmark of a Christian heart. Jesus exemplified humility by serving others and putting their needs above His own (Philippians 2:3-8). A humble heart recognizes its own limitations and relies on God's strength and guidance.
- 4. Faith and Trust A Christian heart is rooted in faith and trust in God. This involves believing in God's promises and trusting Him in all circumstances, even when life is challenging. Faith provides the strength to persevere and the hope that God is always in control.
- **5. Service to Others** Service is a natural outflow of a Christian heart. Jesus taught that greatness in God's kingdom is measured by our willingness to serve others (Mark 10:43-45). This means using our time, talents, and resources to help those around us.
- **6. Joy and Peace** A Christian heart experiences joy and peace that come from a relationship with God. This joy is not dependent on external circumstances, but is a deep-seated contentment and peace that comes from knowina and trustina (Philippians 4:7).

A Christian heart is one that reflects the character of Jesus Christ. It is marked by love, forgiveness, humility, faith, service, and a profound sense of joy and peace. Cultivating these qualities helps Christians live out their faith in a way that honors God and blesses others.
